### 2026 Sports Expression of Interest (current Years 4 & 5 students in 2025)

Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

The following information relates to students in Years 5 & 6 in 2026, who would like to represent Coomera Rivers State School in extra-curricular sport. This is an expression of interest only and does not guarantee selection. Most events will require a selection trial.

We ask that parents speak with their child and indicate below (by ticking) which sports events they would like their child to be considered for and return the completed form to the office. If your child is unsure about a particular sport event, we suggest selecting it just in case they may be interested.

Please note, some events may require transport costs to be paid by parents e.g. Interschool Sport. Transport costs will be invoiced prior to the event.

This permission form must be returned to the office by **Friday of Week 2, Term 1, 2026 (6<sup>th</sup> Feb)**. Only students who have expressed interest via this permission note will be invited to trial for selected sport events.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Behaviour: Students must maintain satisfactory or better behaviour and effort across all areas of schooling to be eligible.
- Attendance: Consistently strong attendance is also a key requirement when selecting teams.

### UNIFORMS IN 2026

In 2026, we are moving to parents purchasing sport team uniforms rather than hiring them.

- Families will be required to purchase the uniform for their child to participate.
- Multiple uniforms may be required if your child wishes to participate across multiple sports. Please check the "Uniform Needed" column in the tables below.
- Once purchased, the uniform will remain the students to keep.
- Uniforms do not need to be purchased until confirmation has been given that your child has been selected for a team.
- All uniforms listed are Coomera Rivers-specific and need to be purchased through the school.
- All sports require students to wear white quarter-length crew socks as part of their playing kits, unless specified otherwise.
- All students must arrive to school or venue in their black sport shoes (No slides or crocs)
- Students will get changed into their playing shoes / boots at the venue.

## CODE OF CONDUCT – COOMERA RIVERS STATE SCHOOL SPORTS TEAM

Students selected for a Coomera Rivers State School Sports Team will be aware of, and comply with, the following code of conduct to retain their position in the team. Non-compliance with this code of conduct may result in suspension from the team for a period of time determined by the school, with further action taken by the school if deemed necessary.

Students will:

- Commit to Service – Action – Respect in all aspects of school life including their involvement in their chosen sport.
- Demonstrate exemplary behaviour at all times whilst at training and in general school life.
- Demonstrate compliance with the Coomera Rivers State School Student Code of Conduct at training, at games, and in general school life.
- Demonstrate sportsmanship at all times at training and in general school life e.g. positive comments only.
- Demonstrate respect to coaches/umpires/referees and play according to the rules.
- Encourage all players to do their best.
- Demonstrate full involvement in and commitment e.g. attend training sessions, and play any position in games.
- Demonstrate school spirit through supporting other players.
- Demonstrate respect for sports equipment by using equipment appropriately.
- Help with the transportation of necessary equipment.
- Take care of and return any equipment provided by the school.
- Respect the selection and field position process.
- Demonstrate appropriate sun smart behaviours.
- Work hard to achieve the best possible performance from themselves whilst enjoying the experience.

## Activity risks and insurance

The Department of Education does not have personal accident insurance cover for children/students. If a child/student is injured as a result of an accident or incident while participating in the activity, all costs associated with the injury, including medical costs are the responsibility of the parent/carer. Some incidental medical costs may be covered by Medicare. If the parent/carer has private health insurance, some costs may also be covered by your provider. Any other costs must be covered by the parent/carer. It is up to the parent/carer to decide the type/s and level of private insurance they wish to arrange to cover their child. Please take this into consideration in deciding whether or not to allow the child/student to participate in this activity.

- I accept liability for all reasonable costs incurred by the department in obtaining such medical assistance or treatment (including any transportation costs) and undertake to reimburse the department the full amount of those costs.
- I have provided the school with all relevant details of the child/student's medical or physical needs on registration/enrolment and where relevant have updated this information.
