## **School Policy Document**

Latest community review - February 2015

We are happy to assist families who allow their children to ride a bicycle to school by providing suitable storage at school. However, we have a list of common-sense rules that must be followed. They are:

## **Bicycles**

- Parents are responsible for allowing their children to ride their bicycle to & from school each day after considering traffic and weather conditions.
- Bicycles must be stored in the designated bike racks
- Riders must wear an approved helmet while riding. This is responsible practice and the law.
- Riders must dismount at the school gate and push their bike to the racks. Bicycles cannot be ridden in the school grounds.
- Children are encouraged to chain their bike to the racks to prevent theft.

Consequences for continual breach of rules...

- 1. Students will be given 1 reminder
- 2. Families notified by email for second offence
- 3. A second offence may result in the:
  - Bike not being allowed to come onto the school campus for 1 week
  - Bike not being allowed to come onto the school campus for 1 month
  - Bike not being allowed to come onto the school campus for 1 term
  - Bike not being allowed to come onto the school campus indefinitely

The school accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of bicycles. We assume that parents have knowingly allowed their children to bring them to school and are aware of any risks involved.

Scooters, Skateboards and Skates

NO scooters, skateboards and skates are permitted at school.
