STEP 1 - Week 5 Tuesday 25th February

Completed applications must be delivered to the office for Mrs Ellison.

STEP 3 – Ongoing and prior to each event/activity Successful students will be invited to a meeting in the Arts room opposite the DigiDesign room. Applications may reopen through the year in the case of limited student numbers to lead events/activities.
