


'Digital Leader' Application: Student Leadership



OPEN to all students in Years 6

In 2025, Coomera Rivers State School will provide an opportunity for interested students in Years 6, to take on the role as a 'Digital Leader' in our school. A Digital Leader learns what it takes to be a positive digital citizen through cyber-safety awareness and understanding as well as learn how to troubleshoot IT problems and support learning using iPads.

A Digital Leader will not only work with other Digital Leaders to support their class, and their teacher, they will also be required to support other classes in other year levels.

* Students applying should have consistently very good behaviour and effort, noted on their most recent report card. * Students applying must commit to regular meetings and activities, including supporting other classes, and teachers, across the school. There will be at least 5 meetings each semester during 1st break.

* There can be multiple 'Digital Leaders' in each Year 6 class.

* Students can apply for, and hold, multiple leadership roles in the school.

TIMELINE OF 'DIGITAL LEADER' SELECTION PROCESS - 2025 TERM 1

STEP 1 – Week 3 Monday 10th February

Mrs Lord will introduce the 'Digital Leader' student leadership opportunity to the Year 6 cohort and provide the application form to interested students (extra copies will be outside the DigiDesign room Monday and Tuesday).

STEP 2 – Week 3 Friday 14th February

Completed applications must be delivered to Mrs Lord in the DigiDesign room.

STEP 3 – Week 4

Eligible students will be invited to the first meeting in the DigiDesign room.
