

Parent Checklist – Preparing for your child to bring their iPad to school

WHY iPad = Accelerate SPEL – Skillset, Productivity, Engagement and Learning outcomes.

HOW = Consume – Create – Collaborate (*Consume content – Create content – Collaborate with others*).

- Ensure your child has an iPad to bring to school to support them with their learning (refer [Student iPad Requirements](#)).
- Repair any damages** to the iPad. This includes cracked glass screens.
- [Create an Apple ID for your child](#).
- Add a **Passcode** to your child's iPad (a Department of Education Queensland requirement for inTune, **students require a passcode to unlock their iPad**).
- Add a **Lock Screen photo** of your child's face (for ease of identification if the iPad is misplaced). Students will also be required to have their **iPad named** with their current class e.g. 4A John S (Go to Settings – General – About – Name).
- Enable** = Speak Selection / Dictation / Dictionary / Predictive Text.
- Disable** = iCloud Photos / Offload Unused Apps.
- Install and setup **inTune Company Portal app** on your child's iPad (refer to [setup process document](#) or [setup process video](#)).
- [Setting Parental Controls](#), will allow parents to setup screen time and restrict content and apps students are able to access.
- [Download the Required Apps](#) on your child's iPad, **via the inTune Company Portal app**. Our school has purchased all apps apart from Book Creator for Years 2-6. Parents **do not** need to purchase other apps **nor** pay for in app purchases for any apps.
- Update your child's iPad** to the latest version of iOS. Settings – Software Update. Also **update school apps**.
- Check the **storage space** on your child's iPad and delete photo/video from the camera roll (and recently deleted folder). Go to Settings – General – iPad Storage.
- Delete home apps that are no longer used** or that take up a lot of storage.
- Delete school content, in apps, that is no longer needed** e.g. Book Creator, Pic Collage, Keynote, Pages, Clips, etc.
- Discuss the [CRSS iPad Expectations](#), [Cybersafety Expectations](#) and [Digital Devices Responsible User Agreement](#) with your child. These documents can be found on our school website: www.coomerariversss.eq.edu.au
- You are aware of the log in details, user name and password, for your child for the following (*these will be provided after the start of the school year unless otherwise already known*). Other apps may request a user name and password to be created, there is **no need to do so** unless requested by your child's class teacher.
 - **Network** (MIS id and password), **IXL**, **Raz**, **Vocabulary A-Z**, **Epic**, **Decodable Readers** (Prep – Year 2)
- Accept the Invitation** for your child's **Seesaw Classes**.
- Read the Department of Education, [Cybersafety: Information for Parents and Carers](#).
