For all Year 5 & 6 students wishing to participate in Sport Events in 2025

Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

The following information relates to students in Years 5 & 6 in 2025, who would like to represent Coomera Rivers State School in any extra-curricular sport.

We ask that parents speak with their child and indicate (by ticking) below which events they would like to be considered for, and return the completed form to the office. Most events will require a selection trial.

Once the completed form is returned, we will then invoice a refundable uniform bond of \$50 plus the total of uniform hire for each selected event (\$5 per event). The total of this needs to be paid which must be paid by **Friday of Week 6, Term 1, 2025 (7th March)**. Payment plans can be organised through our Finance Officer.

The bond payment will be refunded at the end of the year, following team uniforms having been returned in good order. If your child is not selected in a particular event, but they have paid for the uniform hire, parents will be entitled to a refund of the uniform hire for those events, at the conclusion of the year.

If your child is unsure about a particular event, we suggest selecting it just in case they may be interested, as students will not have the opportunity to join or trial at a later date.

Please note, this permission and total cost is for uniforms only. Transport fees will be additional at the time of the event, if required.

This permission form must be returned to the office by **Friday of Week 2, Term 1, 2025 (7th Feb)**. Payment will be required by **Friday Week 6, 2024 (7th March)**. Please contact our Finance Officer should you wish to discuss payment options.

Uniform Process

Team Uniform / School Uniform

When students wear their team uniform, they **MUST** wear either the allocated team uniform socks or white quarter-length school socks. They **MUST** also wear black school sport shoes, as per the school Uniform Policy. Students **MUST** wear a school hat with the Coomera Rivers logo. Crocs and thongs are never allowed to be worn prior, during or after game days. Students who do not follow these expectations will not be allowed to participate on game days.

Collection

Prior to an event, the HPE team will communicate a pick-up window with students and families. We need to staff the uniform shop to handout uniforms; students must collect during this window or they will not be eligible to play. If for some reason, a student cannot collect their uniform during this window, a mutually agreeable time must be organised by the parent with Corina Profke (cprof13@eq.edu.au) before the collection window closes.

Return

At the end of each event, the following process must be followed:

- The HPE Team will communicate a return window
- The uniform must be washed
- Students must return during the return window
- Parents can return to the office during the school day of the return window

Note: If students do not return their uniform during the allocated window, they will not be eligible for the next sporting event. Should students fail to return uniforms, they will forego their bond and will not be eligible for any further sporting events.

Behaviour

For students to be eligible for sport, they must have satisfactory or better behaviour and effort in all aspects of their schooling. This includes the classroom, specialist lessons and outside the classroom.

Attendance

School attendance is important, and this will be taken into consideration when we select our teams.

Interschool Sport

Students can only participate in one sport per term, however if they can't decide which one they want to choose right now, we suggest picking more than one. CODE OF CONDUCT – COOMERA RIVERS STATE SCHOOL SPORTS TEAM

Students selected for a Coomera Rivers State School Sports Team will be aware of, and comply with, the following code of conduct to retain their position in the team. Non-compliance with this code of conduct may result in suspension from the team for a period of time determined by the school, with further action taken by the school if deemed necessary.

Students will:

- Commit to Service – Action – Respect in all aspects of school life including their involvement in their chosen sport.
- Demonstrate exemplary behaviour at all times whilst at training and in general school life.
- Demonstrate compliance with the Coomera Rivers State School Student Code of Conduct at training, at games, and in general school life.
- Demonstrate sportsmanship at all times at training and in general school life e.g. positive comments only.
- Demonstrate respect to coaches/umpires/referees and play according to the rules.
- Encourage all players to do their best.
- Demonstrate full involvement in and commitment e.g. attend training sessions, and play any position in games.
- Demonstrate school spirit through supporting other players.
- Demonstrate respect for sports equipment by using equipment appropriately.
- Help with the transportation of necessary equipment.
- Take care of and return any equipment provided by the school.
- Respect the selection and field position process.
- Demonstrate appropriate sun smart behaviours.
- Work hard to achieve the best possible performance from themselves whilst enjoying the experience.
