## This funding will be used to:

- Ensure the explicit teaching of reading, and rigorous application of school agreed practises, by continually building teacher capacity through coaching.
- Ensure the routine collection and analysis of reading data and tracking of targeted reading goals to improve outcomes in reading for every student.
- Provide targeted reading programs for every student from P-2 and intensive reading intervention for selected students in response to data, to improve outcomes in reading.

## Our initiatives include:

- Creating opportunities within a professional learning community for teachers to critically reflect on student learning with guidance from Heads of Department, Deputy Principals and Principal, in order to evaluate teaching strategies and identify successful practice.
- Targeting Prep, Year 1 and Year 2's reading by embedding our cohesive approach to the teaching of reading and writing with a focus on phonics.
- Providing intensive intervention programs for identified students across all year levels in the school, in response to data, to improve their reading outcomes.
- Continually improving teacher instructional capability in reading and school pedagogical practises through a comprehensive coaching plan: instructional coaching; collegial coaching and mentoring.
- Using Professional Learning Teams and Year level teams to review and track learning for every student in reading against school targets and apply universal, targeted and intensive interventions to maximize learning outcomes for every student.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employing three full time Heads of Department to support teaching of reading. \$351,084

Employing Read Write Inc Assistant Teachers to assist with phonics and intervention program implementation. \$65,000
